JUSTICE and PEACE group – which campaigns for a fairer world and for an end to wars

SVP (St. Vincent de Paul Society) – which helps local people who are having problems

If only people loved one another

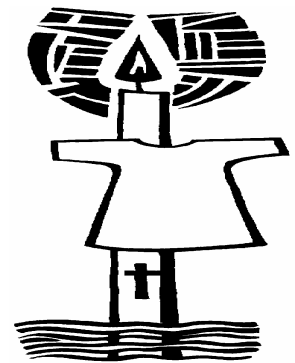
RE 6
